#### About Music for Schools

Music for Schools, our instrument lending library, provides all students the opportunity to participate in their school's band or orchestra program. Working directly with schools and teachers, instruments are loaned to students for the entire school year, completely free of charge.

Since its inception in 2000, the lending library has grown from a small collection of core instruments to more than 500 instruments of all types. This has been made possible through the generosity of donors, as well as our annual instrument drive held each spring.

Unfortunately, as a result of the Tubbs Fire on October 8, 2017, the storage facility containing 400+ instruments was burned. None of the instruments survived, resulting in a loss of about \$250,000.
